SESSION PLAN: What makes iSimangaliso special

SESSION OBJECTIVES:

- The objective of this session is for learners to understand and appreciate the beauty and offerings of the World Heritage Site iSimangaliso Wetland Park.

INTRODUCTION ACTIVITY:

- Ask the learners what makes iSimangaliso so special – *write these answers down on the board.*
- Show the learners What Makes Isimangaliso Special Video - <https://tinyurl.com/4hkt8ymv>

OVERVIEW:

Have a brief discussion about this special place:

South Africa's first World Heritage Site: In 1999, UNESCO declared iSimangaliso a World Heritage Site because of its alarming beauty, abundance of fragile and unique ecosystems, and the intrinsic value such a site has for both South Africans and visitors. With such a title comes a huge responsibility for government and private enterprises to protect and conserve the flora and fauna of the area while using the site to promote economic growth and development. Saved from the unimaginable fate of being a dune mine, iSimangaliso remains a historical, cultural, and natural jewel in South Africa's crown.

MAIN ACTIVITY:

- Learners are to get creative in explaining/describing what makes iSimangaliso unique to them; they could create a poem, song, dance, play, poster, cartoon, story, presentation, art piece, etc., allow them to be creative. Learners can work individually, in pairs, or groups, let them decide.
- Allow each of the groups to present their creation.

CLOSING ACTIVITY:

- Learners write a postcard to a pen pal in uThukela Marine Protected Area (MPA) describing what makes iSimangaliso special and why they might like to come and visit (see ACTIVITY provided below)

FOLLOW UP SUGGESTIONS:

Take the learners on an exploration in iSimangaliso Wetland Park, northern KZN.
